The general nature of the business to be conducted under the licence is a tavern. The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is currently sold under the On Licence are Mo to Su 8am to 11pm & 12 times per year: 8am to 12.30am. The days on which and the hours during which alcohol is intended to be sold under the On Licence are Mo to Su 8am to 12am; New Years Eve 8am to 2am; under the Off Licence are Mo to Su 8am to 11pm. It is intended to alter the licensed area by increasing the building footprint which is shown on a plan accompanying the application. The variation of conditions is sought to change the activity from a restaurant to a tavern. (Online notice 26/03/19). The application may be inspected during ordinary office hours at the offices of Auckland Council at Orewa, Takapuna, Henderson, Manukau, Papakura, Pukekohe and 35 Graham Street, Auckland Central. Any person who is entitled to object and wishes to object to the variation or renewal of the licence may, not later than 15 working days after the first date of the publication of this notice on the site [www.alcoholnotices.co.nz](http://www.alcoholnotices.co.nz), file a notice in writing of the objection with the Secretary of the District Licensing Committee, Auckland Council, Private Bag 92300, Victoria St West, Auckland. No objection to the variation of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 105(1) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012. No objection to the renewal of a licence may be made in relation to a matter other than a matter specified in section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
